- The Financing Agency for Social Entrepreneurship (FASE) supports selected social entrepreneurs in raising growth capital and connects them with investors and financiers across the entire spectrum.
- BonVenture invests in social entrepreneurs, at their early or growth stages, who solve pressing social or ecological problems and wish to increase their social impact.
- BayStartUP is a Bavarian institution that prepares startups and social entrepreneurs for investors talks and connects them with investors and business angels.
- Angel Funding Germany is a cross border initiative connecting growth companies to German business angels and venture capitalists in one of the following sectors: ICT, Life Sciences, Medtech, Health, Agro/Food or Cleantech.
